



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print out the sheets separately. (I had to select "Fit" for it print correctly)
2. Cut the book marks out. I used a paper cutter for the straight edges then hand cut around the tab. For the tops I just cut around the edges.
3. Fold the bookmarks in half (being sure to have the tabs lined up).
4. Once you have them folded correctly, open the bookmark to the not-printed side, and add a little glue to the insides of the folded bookmarks - but not in the half circle tab areas at the top,
5. Fold the bookmarks back over to glue them down.
6. Now fold the tab down, so you will see a non printed area facing up, but spread it out at the top like it is a plate sitting on top of your bookmark. Add a little glue to the top of the tabs which now make a small circle. Take the top and press it down onto the glue on the tab.
7. You can mix and match but the bookmark on the left is intended to use the butterfly top, the center one the pumpkin, and the right one the seater. But now you should have a cute little bookmark for all your cozy days reading!
